Combine Trials

The Irish Rugby Football Union are to hold three Women's Sevens Rugby Combine Trial sessions during February 2017. Aimed at identifying athletic talent with the potential to be selected to represent the Ireland Women Sevens programme within the World Rugby Women's Sevens Series, the IRFU are keen to identify and develop Irish qualified athletes to enhance the women's squad in their drive for international silverware and Olympic qualification.

The Combine Trials will be open to any quality athlete, even those with no previous rugby experience. If you feel you have the athletic ability to perform on the world stage, are over 18 years of age and are Irish qualified* the IRFU would like you to apply. Applications will then be informed via email if they have been invited to trial with further information of the day's schedules included.
